MEDICALS FOR DRIVERS LICENCE

1. The date your licence expires is shown on the back, (Birthday and Year).
2. Your Medical is due:

<u>Age at Last Medical Report</u>	<u>Next Medical Due at Age</u>
39 and under	every five years
40	5 years to age 45
41	5 years to age 46
42	4 years to age 46
43	3 years to age 46
44 to 62	every three years
63	2 years to age 65
64	1 year
65 and over	annually

Please remember that it is your responsibility to submit your Medical Report to the MTO.

3. Fax Medical to Ministry @ 416-235-3400. Call Ministry a week later @ 416-235-1773 to confirm they received it.
4. Keep copy of your Medical for your records.
5. Helpful Suggestion: Attach a small piece of masking tape on the back of your licence and write down the date you faxed your Medical to the Ministry.
6. To find out when your Medical is due, phone the Ministry of Transportation @ 416-235-1773.
